**EFFECTIVE: March 20, 2020**

As of March 20, 2020, the Tribal Community of Akiachak has directed non-residence to ceased entering the community, residents are informed not to enter any other community to prevent the spreading of COVID -19. For pre-cautionary reasons community members are informed to follow these Guidelines listed below

1. All travel into the community by non-members is now suspended indefinitely, residents are told to limit travel to and from Bethel or any other community unless it is for medical reasons (However for any subsistence needs or gathering of resources is allowed for residence of Akiachak) (Ice Jigging, Hunting, gathering woods. Etc.)
2. If you had any visits in Anchorage or out of state, please quarantine yourself and your family for 14 Days
3. All social gatherings will be limited to 10 people within community facilities, as a reminder residents are told to be within 6 feet of each other in public.
4. Employees who are sick are advised to stay home and inform their employer
5. For any symptoms of **COVID-19** (initial flu-like symptoms, such as fever, coughing, breathing difficulties, fatigue, and myalgia) residents are urges to call the local Clinic first to be interviewed and diagnosed of COVID-19 or any other illnesses. 825- 4011
6. Parents are advised to keep your children at home to prevent the spread of any illnesses, Parents are also advised that curfew is at 9:00 P.M from Monday thru Friday including weekends for their children.
7. Akiachak Limited and its Subsidiaries, and The Akiachak Native Community also inform the Community not to hang-out at any of their Facilities to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. (Akiachak Limited, Akiachak IRA Office, Akiachak Fuel Sales, Kalikiwik, Akiachak Enterprise's, Akiachak Hardware Store, Akiachak Police Station, Etc.)

**Akiachak Traditional-Council is looking after the well-being of our community. This is to PROTECT THE SAFETY OF OUR PEOPLE, as a reminder Akiachak is a dry Village and ALCOHOL within the community is prohibited. QUYANA...**
